




ANTIDOTE (detail)

Hand-cut paper, 145 x 165 cm




INSTIL (detail)



Adam Ball creates intricate and evocative abstractions drawn from nature, and scientific and biological systems, including imagery that typically remains unseen. Through a rigorous process of reduction and transcription, he brings this hidden visual information into view, transforming it into immersive fields that disrupt scale and spatial perception. The resulting images retain a sense of motion and rhythm, revealing the beauty of everyday life and reshaping how we visually connect with the world.

His private commissions are often months in the making, forming a close collaborative relationship with his clients; creating highly personal and resonant pieces which take centre stage in many private residences around the world.






